

## 2019-2020 Art Opportunities

These are the art class opportunities for 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students who have completed Art Design 1,2 AND Art Design 3,4

Studio Drawing & Painting: This yearlong course provides an opportunity for students to expand on the art principles introduced in Art 1,2 and 3,4. This studio class will allow students to continue to develop abilities that are necessary for AP art classes. The class will consist entirely of studio projects and weekly sketchbook assignments. There will be freedom to explore ideas and work in a variety of media. Students will have many choices and have the ability to work on projects of their choice. Class is worth 5 credits per semester.

AP Studio Art 2-D/ AP Studio Art Drawing: This yearlong course is designed for students who are seriously interested in the practical experience of art and wish to develop mastery in the concept, composition, and execution of their ideas. Students will submit digital portfolios at the end of the school year. Students who pass the portfolio will receive college credit for a beginning art class. Summer work is required. There is a textbook with weekly quizzes. There are sketchbook assignments and written critiques. This is a college level course and is worth 5 credits per semester. It is worth 5 GPA points for students earning an A.

Ms. Morrow will be meeting with students individually to discuss placement in these classes. All are welcome to sign up for the Studio class. Approval must be given to students wishing to sign up for AP as the requirements are substantially more time consuming.
